## Non-Profit “Helping Others and Giving Hope” with City of Miami Commissioner Manolo Reyes Organizes Feeding South Florida Food Distribution

“Helping Others and Giving Hope,” founded by sixteen-year-old community activist has partnered with a City of Miami Commissioner to organize a Feeding South Florida Food Distribution in hopes to assist the communities most needy during this pandemic. Feeding South Florida, a Non-for-Profit Organization has partnered with Commissioner Manolo Reyes and a non-profit called “Helping Others and Giving Hope,” which is run by sixteen-year-old community activist, to provide approximately 1500 families with about 25 pounds each of nonperishable food including vegetables, bread, and juice, and more.

“After seeing the stress that this global pandemic has caused to those who have lost their jobs and the community around the world, I felt like this was the proper event to host for those going through difficult times. I have seen the need in our community firsthand while hosting my own food distributions and volunteering with other local groups during these rough times. This seemed as a great opportunity for me to give back to my community as I love to do.
